IMPORTANT: PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY

1. Dumpsters and portable storage units must be located in the back half of the front yard, side yard or back yard.
2. Dumpsters and portable storage units must be clean and free of holes.
3. Dumpsters may not be filled above the rim and debris must not be visible from the street.
4. Dumpsters must be emptied at least once in every 30-day period.
5. Dumpsters, portable storage units and construction trailers may not obstruct or interfere with the safe operation of motor vehicles or the safety of pedestrians.
6. Construction trailers are permitted in the R-2A and R-3 Zone Districts only.
7. Construction trailers may not be used for living, sleeping or housekeeping purposes.
8. Not more than one dumpster, one portable storage unit and one construction trailer are permitted on site.
9. The permit sticker must be clearly displayed on the dumpster, portable storage unit or construction trailer.

I hereby agree to comply with the requirements of Chapter 85 of the Huntington Woods City Code and certify that the owner of the property upon which the dumpster, portable storage unit or construction trailer will be located has given his/her permission for the placement of said equipment.
