### *Upcoming Meetings and Events*

Used book sale at the Library on Saturday, April 1st from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m.

Yard waste collection begins Tuesday, April 4th. Do not place items at the curb before 4 p.m. on the day before pick up.

City Commission meeting on Tuesday, April 4th canceled.

Historic District Commission meeting on Wednesday, April 5th canceled due to lack of business.

### *2017 Road Construction Project Approved*

The City Commission approved the construction of portions of Roycourt and Wyoming at the March City Commission meeting. Wyoming between Borgman and Nadine is slated for reconstruction and a new water main will be installed at the same time. East Roycourt between Victoria and Parkwood Drive will also be reconstructed. In addition to the road work on E. Roycourt, water mains will be replaced and sewer repairs will be done. Work is expected to begin this summer and affected residents will be notified in advance of the construction schedule.

### *Yard Waste and Composting Information*

A few reminders about yard waste pick up which begins this Tuesday. All yard waste must be in a brown kraft yard waste bag or a container with a yard waste sticker. Stickers are available at City Hall or the Department of Public Works. It is against State law to mix yard waste with trash. If you have yard waste to dispose of prior to Tuesday, you may take it to the Troy SOCRRA facility free of charge through April 3rd.

The City also has small curbside containers for your fresh fruit and vegetable scraps that will be picked up at the same time as yard waste. You can purchase a container for \$15 at the Department of Public Works.

## *Fire Hydrant Annual Maintenance to Begin*

The Department of Public Works flushes the City's fire hydrants annually as part of its ongoing maintenance program in April and early May. The City is mailing a letter to each home with specific information on what to expect during the flushing process.

## *Durable Medical Mobility Equipment Loans*

On occasion, the City receives new or slightly-used durable medical equipment that is no longer being used so a loan closet has been established. All equipment loans are free of charge. If you would like to donate standard mobility equipment and related accessories like walkers and wheelchairs, please call Jennifer to make arrangements to drop them off.
