Home Assistance Repair Program Taking Applications

The City's new Home Assistance Repair Program (HARP) was launched in January and several residents have already used the program. HARP helps resident homeowners ages 60 and older maintain their homes and remain independent in their own home for as long as possible. The program is also available to persons of any age with a disability and families that have a family member serving in active duty.

Volunteers perform minor home repairs at no cost to participants other than the cost of required material or supplies. Work performed thus far includes electrical outlet repairs, replaced light fixtures, smoke alarm battery replacement, minor plumbing repairs, hand rail installations and furniture moving. To request a repair or service, complete a form at the Gillham Recreation Center from 9 a.m. - 4 p.m., pick up a form at any City office and return it to the Recreation Center, or fill out a [form](#) online.

Burton School Construction

Weed Control Notice

Notice is hereby given to the owners and occupants of parcels of land in the City of Huntington Woods that any growth of grass or weeds greater than 6 inches in height on the average, or noxious or harmful vegetation not cut between May 1, 2017 and October 1, 2017 will be cut or lawfully destroyed by the City. The cost of cutting is a minimum fee of \$150 for lots with less than 60 feet of frontage and \$200 for lots with over 60 feet of frontage and will be collected as a special assessment against the premises. A civil fine of \$100 for one offense, \$250 for two offenses and \$500 for three or more will be charged in addition to the cost of cutting.
