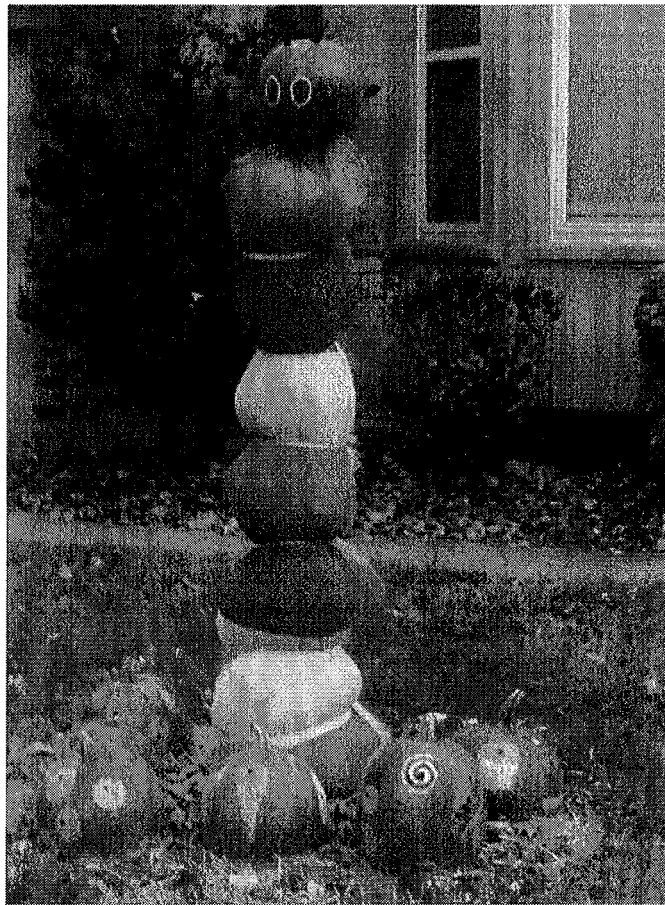

Curb-to-Curb Transportation Available for Seniors

Residents age 55-older who are unable to drive, temporarily or permanently, can make reservations for transportation on the City SMART van for medical appointments, support groups, shopping or other daily activities. The van is wheelchair accessible and has a lift for those who use a walker. Forty-eight hours advance notice is required and the travel distance must be within a seven-mile radius of the City. Please limit reservations to one destination per day. 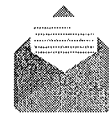
