City Ordinance Prohibits Placing "Free Items" at the Curb

The placement of any item at the curb before 4 p.m. the day before the regular rubbish pick up day is prohibited by City ordinance. Placing items at the curb early encourages scavenging, attracts rodents and is not in keeping with the pride our community takes in its beautiful homes and tree-lined streets.
