Electronics and scrap metal drop off event on Sunday, May 20th from noon - 4 p.m. at the Department of Public Works.

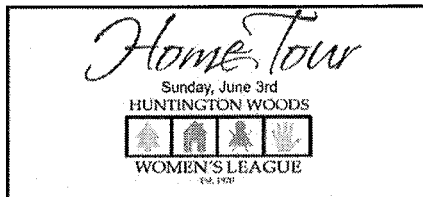
