### *Upcoming Meetings and Events*

### *July 4th Parade and Fireworks*

The 45th annual parade begins at 10 a.m. at Salem and York and ends at Scotia and Nadine due to the renovation of Scotia Park - rain or shine! The theme of this year's parade is America the Beautiful! Please note all 4th of July events including the bake-off, Mayor's speeches and awards, hot dog roast, games and races and the concert will be held at Burton Park.

The fireworks show over Rackham begins approximately 10:05 p.m. The City encourages bicycling and walking due to restricted parking along Ludlow and Scotia.

### *Overnight Parking Policy*

Overnight parking is prohibited between 3 a.m. and 5 a.m. Residents who need to park in the street can call Public Safety at 248.541.1180. Permission to park in the street is given on a case by case basis. Residents need to call each time they need to park overnight. If you need overnight parking for an extended period of time due to extenuating circumstances, please call the Public Safety Department between 8:30 a.m. - 5 p.m. Monday through Friday to arrange for approval from the Public Safety Director. **THIS DOES NOT APPLY TO HOMEOWNERS IMPACTED BY THE ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT.**

### *Keep Outside Water Meter Reader Clear*

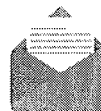
