The 2019 Change of Assessment Notices will be mailed from Oakland County Equalization by mid February. Please review your Change of Assessment Notice carefully. Your 2098 property taxes will be based on the taxable value of your property stated on the notice. Also, if your property in Huntington Woods is your principal residence, 100% should be listed as “Exempt as principal residence”. If you own several properties, only one may be your principal residence.

Appointments are highly recommended for residents wishing to appeal their 2019 assessment to the Board of Review. Meetings are held at City Hall on days listed above.

Persons wishing to apply for a hardship reduction based on limited income should request and submit the required paperwork before Thursday, February 28, 2018 for the application to be considered at the March Board of Review. Those property owners who received a hardship reduction in 2018 must reapply for the 2019 property tax year. Please call the Treasurer for the paperwork to apply. 248 581-2638
