Use of Consumer Fireworks Reminder

Residents are reminded that consumer fireworks may only be discharged between 8 a.m. and midnight the day before, the day of and the day after a national holiday such as the Fourth of July. Failure to abide by the ordinance may result in a municipal infraction and a \$500 fine.

Summer Property Tax Bills

The summer tax bills will be mailed to homeowners without escrow accounts on June 30th. If you do not have an escrow account and have not received a tax bill by July 7th, contact the Treasurer's Office at 248.581.2638. Non-receipt of a tax bill does not negate the homeowner's responsibility to pay. Summer taxes are due on August 10th, 2018. Half payments are allowed if the first half is paid by August 10th and the remainder is paid on or before October 31st, 2018.

City Chipping Operations Delayed

The Department of Public Works chipper is out of commission for an engine repair. Occasionally we are able to borrow a chipper from the City of Berkley but it is not available to us on a full-time basis. This decrease in availability means it will take longer than usual to go through the City. In the meantime, it is advisable to minimize what is placed in the right of way because we can't guarantee it will be picked up on a timely basis. And please remember that contractors and landscapers must remove the material they generate.
